October birthstone is opal and tourmaline. The birth flower is the calendula symbolizing comfort, healing, protection and grace. October was the eighth month in the old Roman calendar. It got its name from the Latin word Octo meaning eight. Later, it became the 10th month when January and February were added to the calendar. October is generally known as the month of haunts, scares, ghouls, leaves changing color and falling from the trees and the first frost of the year. Special holidays in October include Halloween (October 31st), Columbus Day (the second Monday of October), Yom Kipper and International Peace Day (October 2nd).

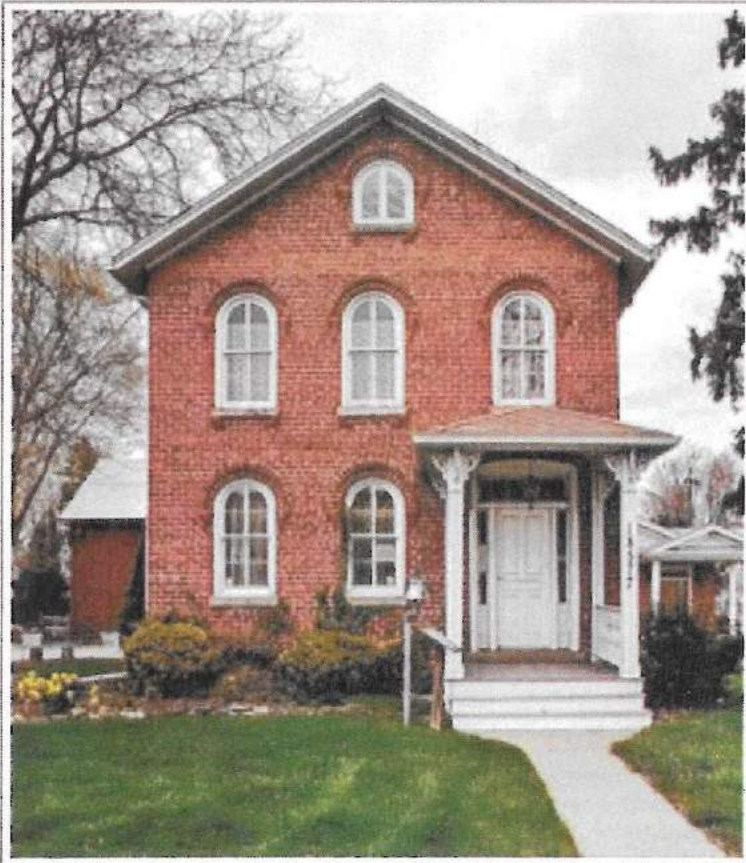

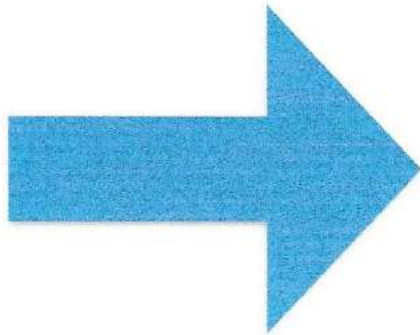

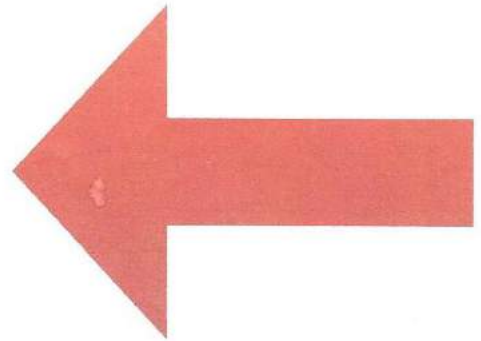
